Piers Fuccini, Tony Cox, Nibs van der Spuy, Dan Patlansky, Andy Turrell, Syd Kitchen and Martin Wolfaardt (to name just a few) lent their considerable talents to the project. In the final analogy its an eclectic largely instrumental album beautifully crafted, honestly recorded and engineered.



Despite the rural remoteness of Peace of Eden there was a constant stream of visitors dropping in to Guy's sessions to listen, add good vibes and give encouragement. We laughed and rapped about the most mundane stuff between takes and somehow the time just flew by.
